WHAT: Walking Safety Assessments

Join the SRTS team on a walk around your school neighborhood to identify barriers and challenges for students walking and biking to/from your school. During the workshop following our walk, we will document your concerns and discuss possible solutions.



WHY: Safe Routes to School Plans

Our engineers and education team will incorporate your feedback into the design of street improvements and safety education. Examples of recommendations may include crosswalks, speed humps, traffic signals, and safety patrols.



WHO: The School Community

We invite parents, grandparents, guardians, caregivers, neighbors, local business owners, and community members to participate in the Walking Safety Assessment.



WHERE: School Entrance

Meet the SRTS team at the LAUSD school entrance 10 minutes before the start time. Additional details will be provided by school administration in the next weeks.
